

ECU STUDENT AMBASSADOR PROGRAM CHINA – 25 November to 10 December 2009

Expressions of interest are sought from students who would like to take part in the ECU Ambassador Program visiting China in 2009. This opportunity is offered to currently enrolled 2nd and 3rd year and post graduate students in the Faculty of Computing, Health and Science, the Faculty of Business and Law and the Faculty of Education and Arts. Places are limited to 20 and will go quickly so get in early to be a part of this exciting program.

The program is conducted in conjunction with Shanghai University of Electric Power (SUEP). SUEP is one of ECU's partners in teaching and research in China.

This will be the fourth consecutive year for the Ambassador Program to China. Previous programs have proven to be very successful and we have received positive feedback from past attendees. Students will be guided by two academic staff supervisors.

The program will be conducted over approximately 2 weeks and students will be visiting Shanghai, Nanjing City, Kunshan City, Zhouzhuang City and Suzhou City. Included are visits to relevant departments at SUEP and other industry organizations. You will attend classes on cultural and educational topics as well as networking with potential future employers and fellow students. An integral part of the tour is interacting with students from SUEP and Nanjing Universities. There will also be opportunities to sightsee the many wonders that China has to offer.
